Use Case Workgroup Progress

Identified 5 Initial Use Case Priority Topics

(based on those identified in legislation)

- Health disparities
- Assessing population health
- Monitoring and analyzing healthcare costs
- Surprise billing
- Consumer pricing portal

Use Case Stories

Presented use case stories for each initial priority topic to stimulate discussion regarding:

- critical technical considerations,
- data considerations,
- data analytics,
- data access/release considerations for APCD, and
- what will be available for use initially vs. over time.





Discussion Highlights and Lessons Learned:

- During the APCD development process, plan for the ability to bring in additional data later
- Value added tools (such as geocoding, risk adjustment) are important for use cases and data analysis; helpful if applied to the APCD database
- Getting more than 3-5 years of historical data from payers may be challenging
- Suggest clearly defining the purpose of the Data Release Review Committee which will help define criteria for data release
- Transparency regarding who is using APCD data, for what purpose, and the outcome or results is important
- Need for a standardized data use agreement

TDR Workgroup Progress

Reviewed strategies to achieve start date for APCD in early 2023

- RFP release and award as soon as possible
- Strong support for submitters, including early collaboration with payers and standardized data layouts
- Phased approach to onboarding submitters
- Close collaboration between all agencies and suppliers to assure data quality and privacy and security standards are established for Georgia's APCD



Key Learnings from Workgroup

- Deidentification should be post-submission
- APCD technology environment should be cloud-based
- APCD development should take a modular approach
- Support for the APCD Common Data Layout (CDL)
- Payers may not have all the data to support use cases
- Payer engagement in the workgroup was valued by all

RFP Research

Research calls were conducted with six organizations who are involved in APCD services in other states to validate our proposed approach

RESEA

Key findings:

- Cloud hosting restrictions
- Frequency of data submissions
- Medicare data
- Data standards continue to evolve



RFP Status Update

- Targeting release in February
- Contract in June/July
- Pilot submissions start in October
- Live in January 2023
- Schedule subject to change based on CMS and the procurement process





APD Update

- Funding request to be submitted to CMS this month
- Funding request is for three years (FFY 2022-2025)
- CMS has up to 60 days to provide a response or ask questions
- CMS reviews RFPs and contracts
- Ten-year budget provided for development and operations
- Cost-benefit analysis specifically based on Medicaid
